## NH House Votes To Ban Dog Racing

CONCORD, N.H. (AP) — The House has voted to ban live dog racing in New Hampshire.

The state's two remaining dog tracks currently don't conduct live greyhound racing and instead provide simulcasts of races held elsewhere. The bill would eliminate the tracks' option of resuming live racing.

Supporters argued the tracks aren't racing dogs now and the state will save money by no longer regulating the activity.

Opponents say the state should let the tracks decide when it made financial sense to offer live racing.
